Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited ("Moray East"), on behalf of Telford Windfarm Limited, Stevenson Windfarm Limited and MacColl Windfarm Limited, having received consent under the above legislation in order to discharge conditions of their Section 36 consents (as varied), wind farm marine licences, the Offshore Transmission Infrastructure ("OfTI") marine licence and Offshore Substation Platform ("OSP") marine licence, has submitted to MS-LOT a revision to the post-consent Lighting and Marking Plan ("LMP").

Please find attached the proposed revision of the LMP. For ease of reviewing a tracked changes version has also been submitted. The purpose of the LMP is to satisfy the requirements of condition 19 of Moray East's Section 36 consents (as varied) awarded to Telford Windfarm Limited, Stevenson Windfarm Limited and MacColl Windfarm Limited on the 19 March 2014 (varied on 22 March 2018), condition 3.2.2.4 of the Telford Offshore Wind Farm, Stevenson Offshore Wind Farm and MacColl Offshore Wind Farm marine licences (licence numbers: MS-00009051, MS-00008985 and MS-00008972, respectively), condition 3.2.2.14 of the OfTI marine licence (licence number: MS-00008919) and condition 3.2.2.5 of the OSP marine licence (licence number: 06347/17/1).

The conditions state that the plan is to be submitted to the Scottish Ministers for their written approval, following consultation with NatureScot, the Northern Lighthouse Board ("NLB"), the Maritime and Coastguard Agency ("MCA"), the Civil Aviation Authority ("CAA"), the Defence Infrastructure Organisation ("DIO"), Aberdeenshire Council, the Highland Council and Moray Council, and any such other advisors as may be required at the discretion of the Scottish Ministers. Any updates or amendments made to the LMP by the Company must be submitted, in writing, by the Company to the Scottish Ministers for their written approval.

We would appreciate any comments you may have on the proposed revision to the LMP, in order to determine whether it is fit for purpose for the Scottish Ministers to give it their written approval. Please note that we do not seek comments on the Consent, the Marine Licence nor on the conditions, which will not be amended.
